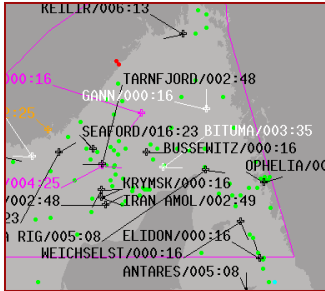
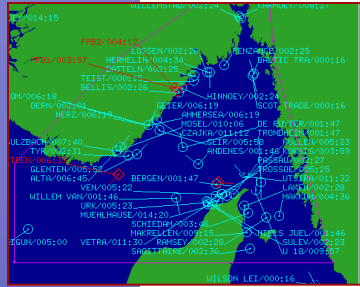

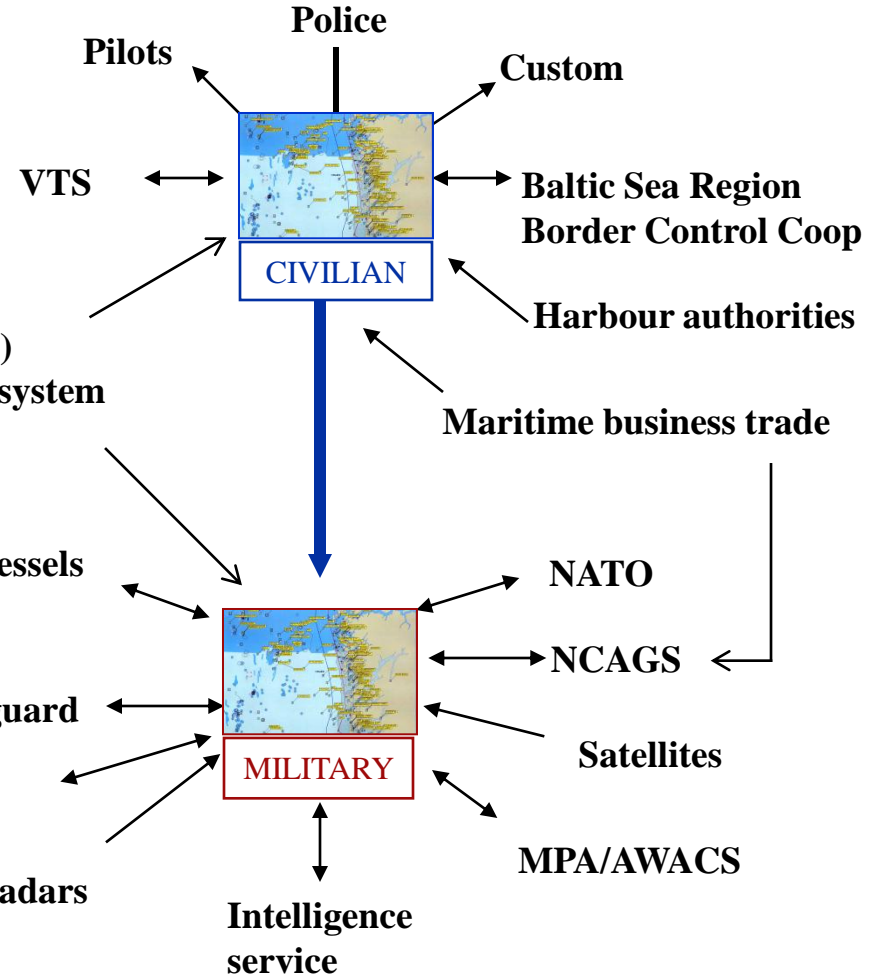


Surveillance "MSA" (Maritime Situation Awareness)

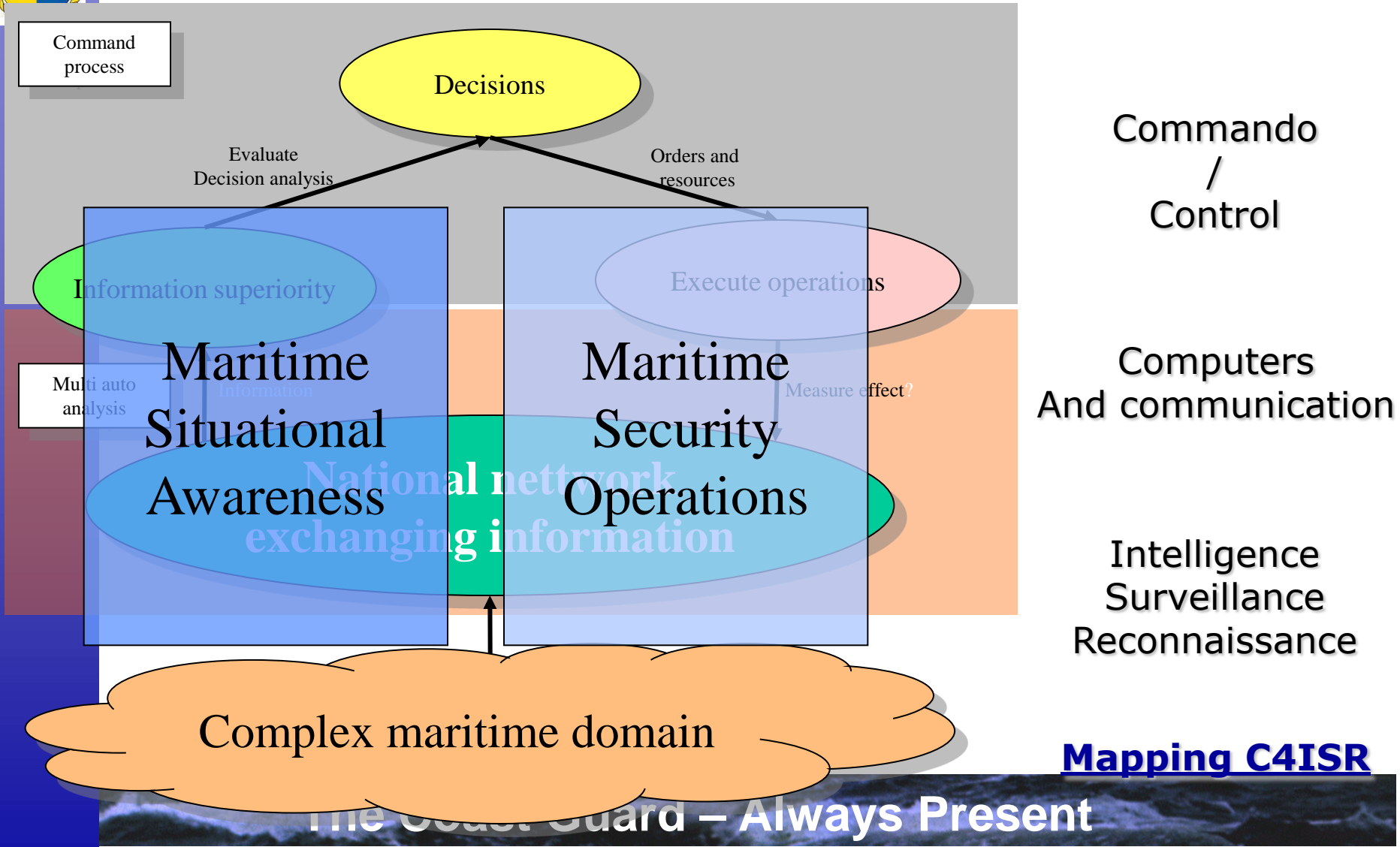

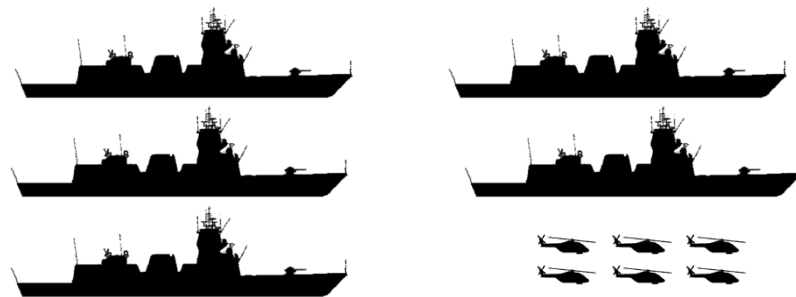
